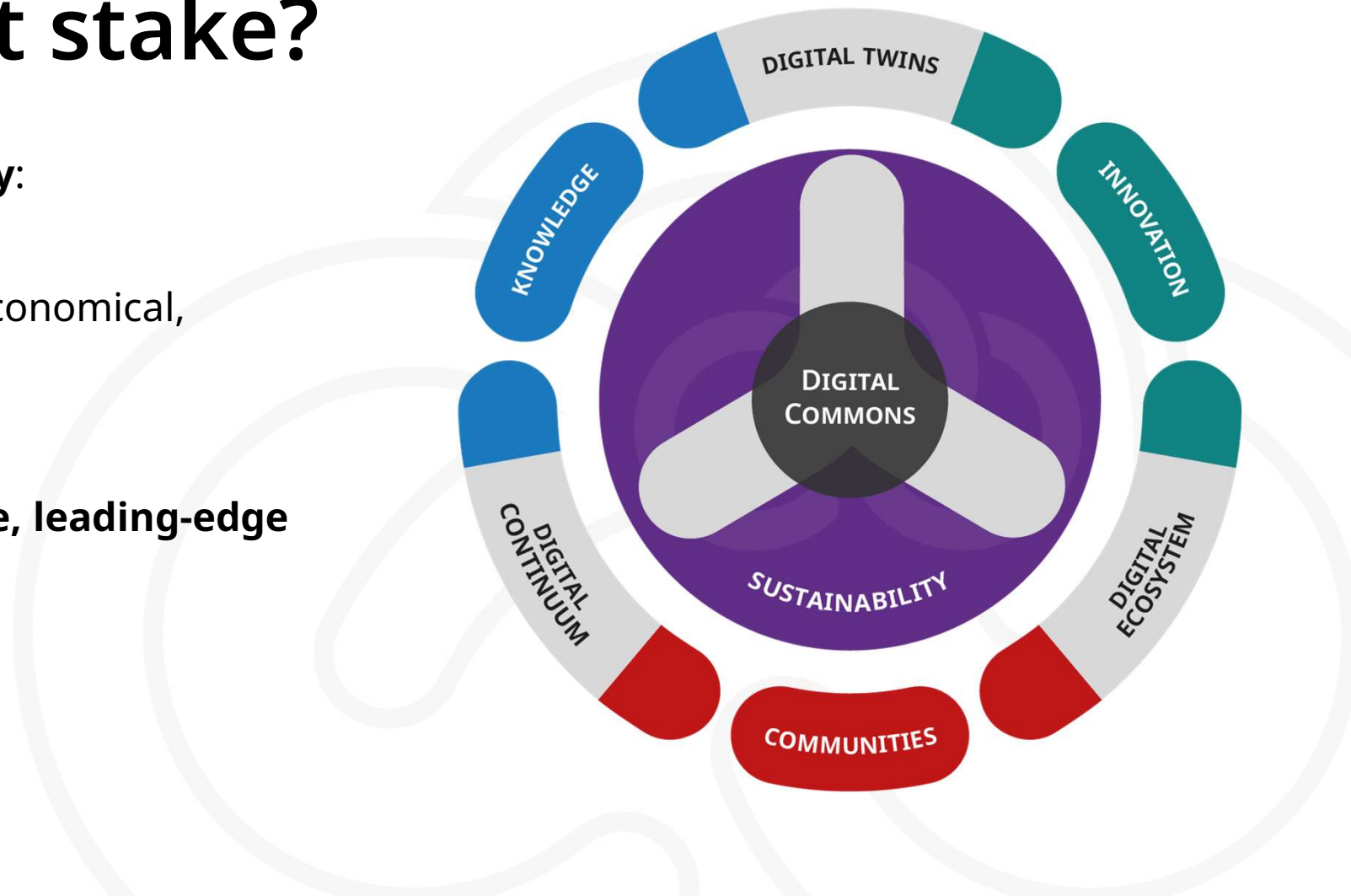

Comparative Analysis: Learn from governance models of other European initiatives.

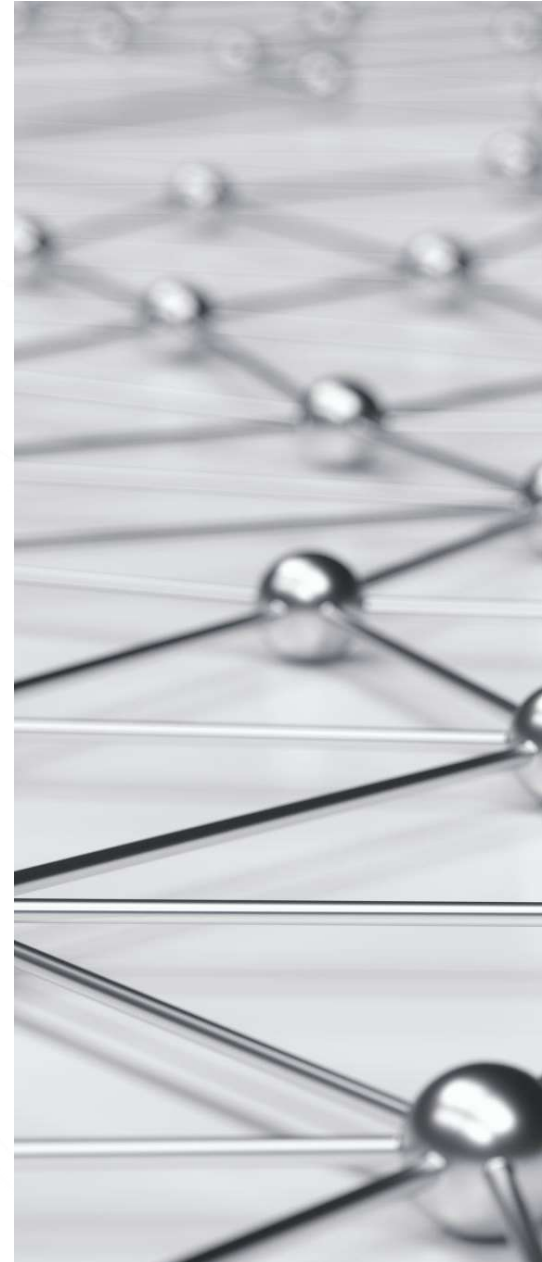
European Requirements: Align governance with EU legal and regulatory frameworks.

Ethical Principles: Focus on transparency, data protection, and security.

Adaptability: Ensure flexibility to meet evolving technological and societal needs.

Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda: Roadmap for maintaining scientific excellence.

Effective operation and financial security: Ensure robust financial management, marketing strategy and open innovation, as well as Environmental, Social, and Governance principles.

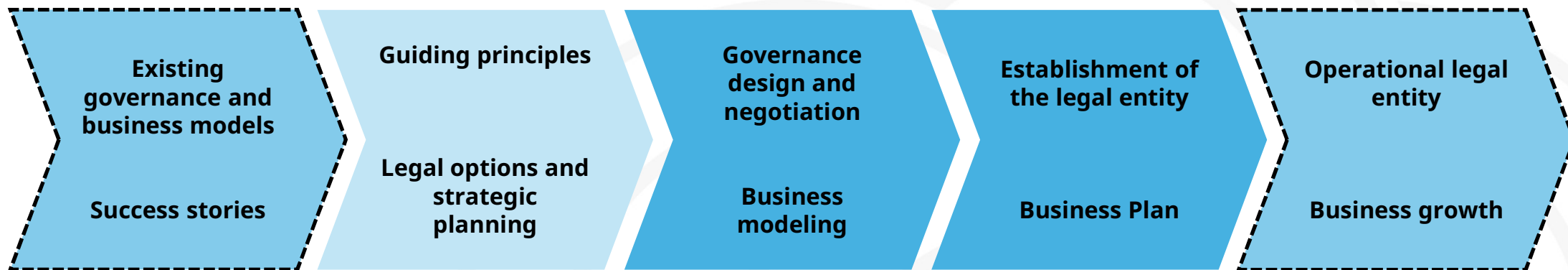
Global Collaboration and Multi-level Investments: Foster cooperation with non-EU entities while driving territorial growth.
