ECHOES Survey initial feedback



The ECHOES Survey received around 800 completed questionnaires which is an excellent result. Several more partially finished submissions can still provide valuable input to the analysis. The respondents are mainly:

- Mid-career professionals (36-55 years)
- Highly educated (masters degree or PhD)
- Mainly working in public non-profit institutions (university, research centres or laboratories, library, archives, museums).

A full summary of the results will be available by the autumn. The survey is the first step of the ECHOES Consultation and will be followed up with workshops, focus groups and targeted interviews. The consolidated results from the Consultation will be ready by May 2026.
